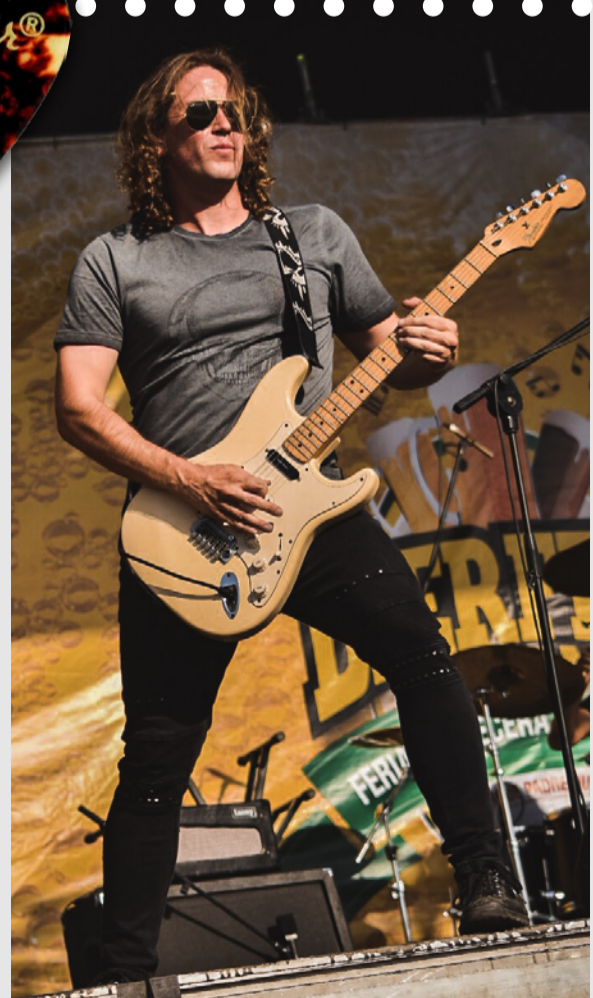

FORAJIDO OF THE MONTH:

GONZALO CARRERE, GENGHIS KHAN BAND



Gonzalo Carrere is a clinical psychologist who has no fear of questioning the status quo, and many know him as a guitar virtuoso. He's also the leader of the band Genghis Khan, which just finished a tour of Chile with **Paul Di'Anno**, the **original vocalist of the legendary band Iron Maiden**, and they filled every venue they played.

How do you feel after sharing the stage with Paul?
First of all, thank you very much for the opportunity to appear as the Forajido of the Month. And thank you for your wine!

Playing with Paul Di'Anno was something else, a whole new level-undoubtedly the best experience in our 18-year career. We had already opened for his shows many times, and we had even been his band member, but this year was completely superior. Probably because the band is more consolidated than ever, and thanks to Herald on guitar and José, who joined in recent years, on drums, as well as our sound and technique, the show reached levels we never imagined.

But the most important thing is that we get along excellently. We're family, we argue sometimes and all, but in the end, love and respect always prevail. That comes through in every show, and Paul noticed it. We were the only band he publicly acknowledged after the tour, and he invited us to accompany him all over South America on an upcoming one! Imagine what that is-what more could we ask for? After the tour with Paul, Genghis Khan is at its best by far!

How do you see the future of rock, considering some of the other rather questionable trends that have appeared?

If rock ends, the world ends. Because even beyond music, it's a reality that unites human beings. It's community. It's alive. It breathes, thinks, and acts. It changes lives and even saves them, as in my case. It always tries to go beyond, to go against the grain. That's why rock can be a revolutionary force-it's hope. And that's its strength. Humanity still needs hope, especially in a world as dark as this one. Its strength is so great that none of that commercial trash from people pushing buttons on a computer can knock it off its throne. Trends have come and gone and will continue to do so, but rock remains-it endures, changes, and grows. We don't really know what shape it will take in the near future, but it will continue to be there as long as there are bands of 17-year-old dreamers who pick up their cheap instruments and rehearse for a gig in the street in front of 3 people.

What's coming up for Genghis Khan this year?
We're going to continue for years. When I started the band 18 years ago, I never thought it would get here. All my girlfriends came and went, literally, and Genghis continued. And today the band is my lover-although don't tell my wife! My entire adolescence was basically Genghis Khan. Today, it's also my long-term, so of course it now works at a different pace. We no longer play two or three times a week for long periods or even every week. Today we definitely prefer quality over quantity. I guess it has to do with being older and more mature. Today it's about music and coming together as a family. After so many years, there's a whole community associated with the band. And it's beautiful to see them at every show, aging with us and bringing in new generations. We're going to continue with that. I think that today, the band's mission is to keep the spirit of Iron Maiden alive, and, through it, the spirit of rock.
