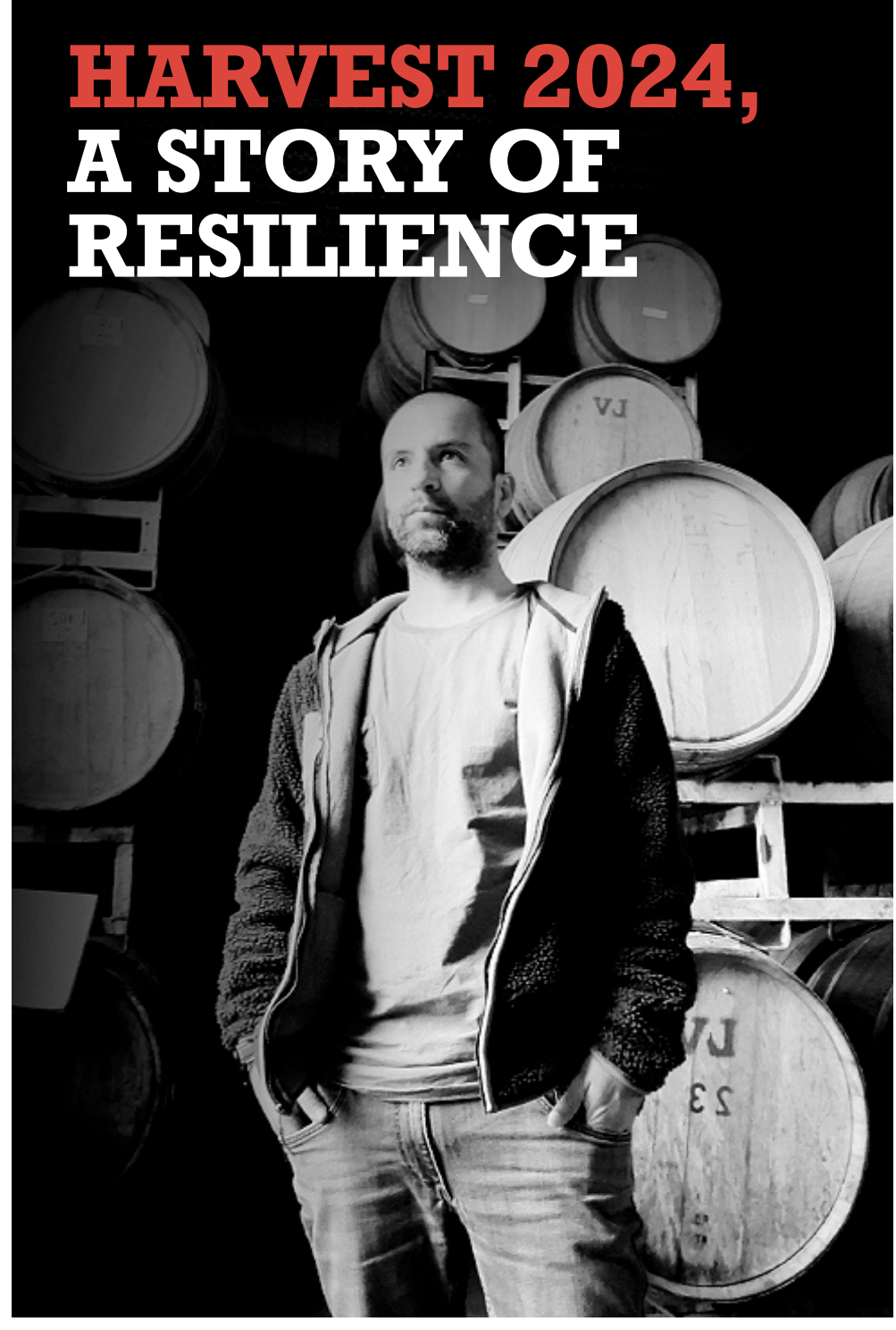


**HARVEST 2024,

"Harvest 2024 has already begun, a new season where **we harvest the grapes that in a little while will be transformed into wine**. But the truth is that this harvest has been different, not in climate, not in intensity, not in quality..., it has been different because most of the small producers are in a critical situation. Many expected that the 2023 harvest would have been the most difficult in terms of prices for the grapes, but 2024 is surprising and unfortunately for the worse, the big companies with low sales early decided not to go out to buy, and this generated that the grapes had no purchase price, and with this panorama the harvest is developing, without an idea of what will happen. Today, with more than a month of harvest, many vines are abandoned, they were not harvested or will not be harvested, since the producer cannot harvest... how can he harvest, if it is more expensive than what he is paid for the grapes, a very bad sign for our industry. The most difficult thing is that many are thinking of uprooting, imagine eliminating vines with 100 or 120 years old, we are uprooting history, life, traditions, and above all a living heritage that we will never recover, this is a story of resilience, that many times these vines have already lived, overcoming rains, fires and droughts, but now it is our turn to live it as producers..., will we be as strong as these vines to resist in the same way? We will know, for the moment we can only move forward, with more courage than ever to continue caring for our little history and make it bigger every day!"

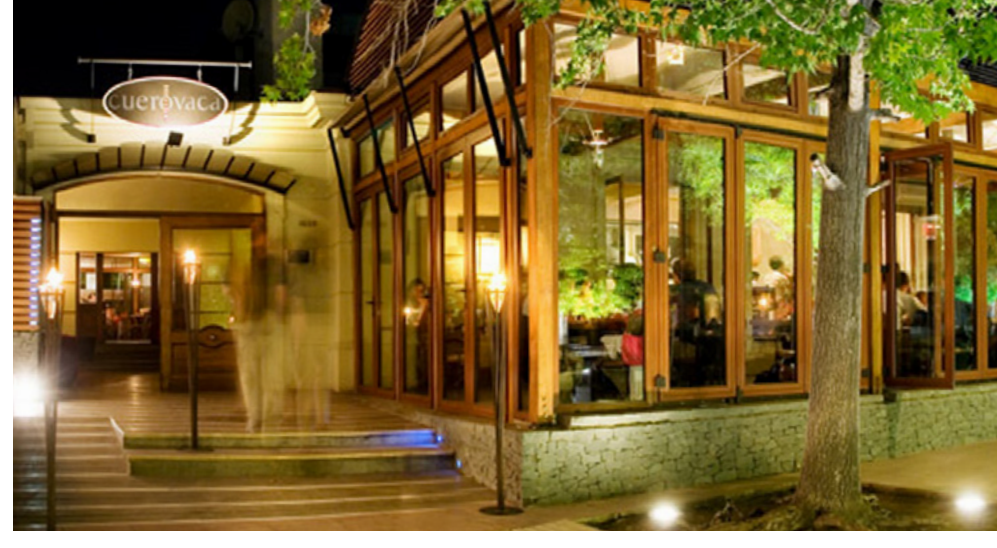
**FORAJIDOS AT PROWEIN

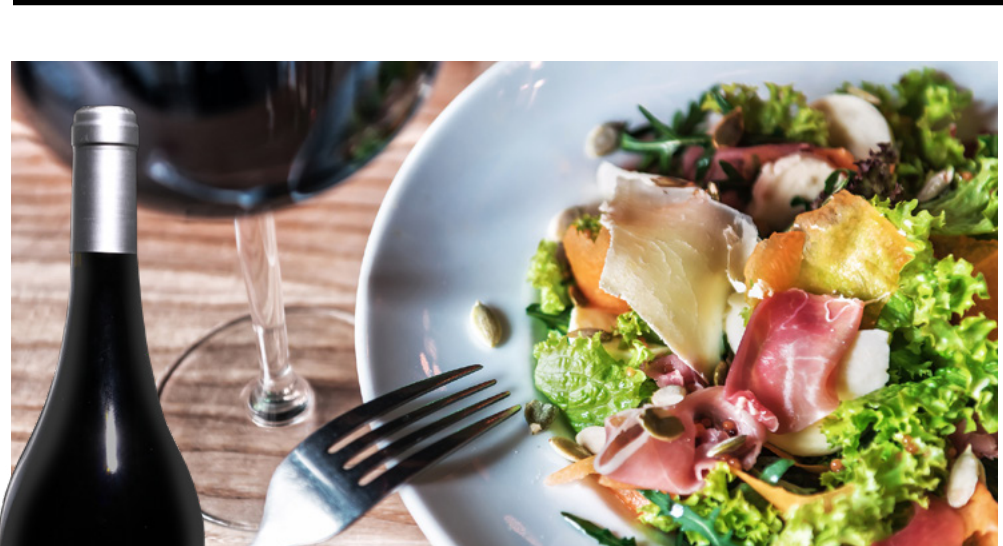

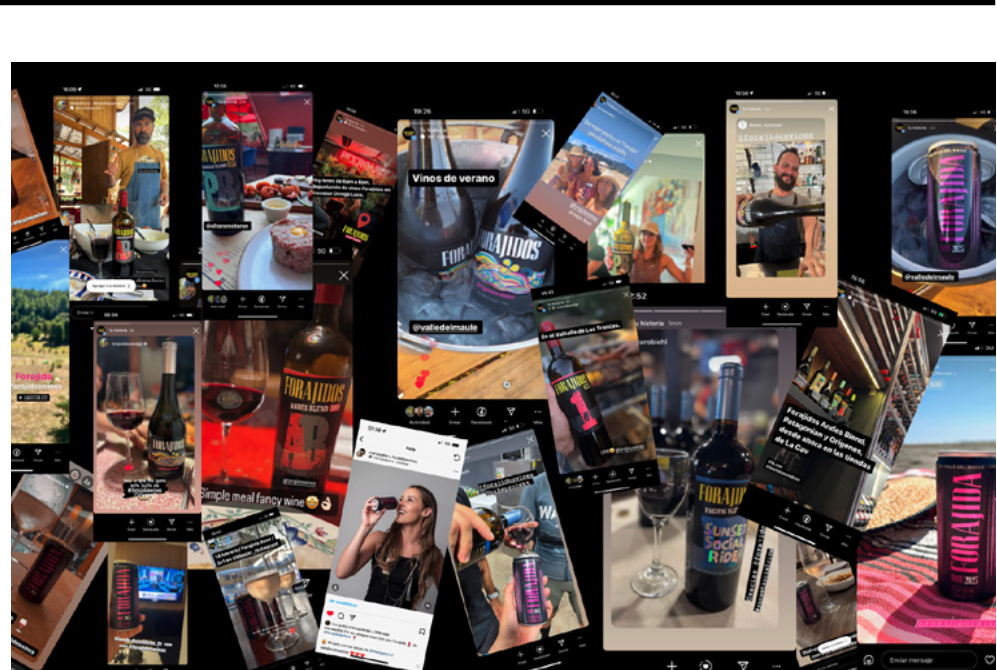
And the last week of February was a big celebration at BKT House, the end of the first cycle of rides, and new sessions have already been announced.

**FELIPE VASQUEZ**

Every now and then you meet people who don't follow the trends, don't fit in with the establishment and challenge the status quo. Those who defy their own limits, grow every day and transform their passions into their daily activities, positively impacting others. We call these people **Outliers**.

Felipe Vasquez, is known by all as one of the pioneers of mountain biking in Chile, and also as one of the references in the evolution of the sport and what it is today, not only on the bike, but also in terms of equipment, new product developments, and today in the implementation of new bike parks in Chile.

**Your whole life has been on a bike, from BMX, XC, road, DH, etc, what is cycling for you?**

It is a lifestyle, since I was 10 years old. It is friendship, work and passion. The bike has been fundamental in everything, thanks to the bike I met my wife, great friends with whom I have shared the best moments, my greatest achievements and has allowed me to travel to spectacular places.

**Farellones / El Colorado is the new center of races, both DH and Enduro this season. What's new about the Bike Park?**

Good ascent logistics, good level of trails and we are always looking for new variations to improve the descents. We have worked hard this season to offer trails for all levels, from pro riders to beginners who want to improve their technique with better prepared trails.

In addition, it has everything you need to race at the highest level, and only 40 minutes from Santiago.

**The bicycle market is undergoing a technological revolution. Where is the sport going?**

The evolution of the sport is moving towards electric bikes. With better and better components, applied technology and more reliable motors.

Even so, analog bikes will not disappear, they will continue to be the gateway to the sport. And in the next 10 years I see a lot of people riding bikes, and the critical mass of riders should grow, as there will be more bike parks, more trails, and people will always be looking to do a sport.
